Classification Training

This is only an option if you have already completed First Class.

Courses are accessed through
'Ultilearn' (<https://learning.bader.mod.uk/>).



Your username is your Cadet Identification Number (the string of numbers at the start of your Cadet Portal login).

Once you've logged in you should be able to access the learning material and exams for the subjects you are registered for.

The password is usually different to your Cadet Portal one. If you don't know your password ask for a reset and we'll get it to you.

Exams can be attempted once every seven days.

If the squadron is closed for an extended period you will be allowed to do all of your exams to complete Master if you wish.




Bronze iDEA Award

Lots of you already have iDEA accounts and have done some of the work!

The iDEA is the digital DofE Award. The Bronze level of the course is one of the modules you have to complete for the **Silver Cyber Badge**.

To register go to: <https://idea.org.uk/> and follow the instructions.

To earn the Bronze level you have to earn 250 points from a variety of modules.



If you complete the Bronze level make sure you send a copy of your certificate to the Training Officer so that it can be recorded.

In the future you will have to complete the Silver level too. If you've got time on your hands why not give it a crack?



Until July 2020 this is the second module you have to complete to achieve the Silver Cyber Badge.

The book has been uploaded to the 'Downloads' section of Cadet Portal for you to access.




British Sign Language

Why not learn a new language? British-sign.co.uk have made their Beginner's level British Sign Language Course free to all under-18s.

You can access the course any time you like and study at your own pace.

Once registered you have access for one year.

Each lesson ends with an assessment that involves watching short BSL videos and answering questions.



Once you have scored 85% in the assessments for each lesson and the final assessment you are awarded a certificate accredited by CPD.
